others agreed. Discussion was had on if the comments should pertain to the agenda items. Mr.

47 Cooley pointed out that their body didn't have jurisdiction to solve problems in the city. Roberts

48 asked for the agenda item to be stated as; "Public Comment Regarding items on the agenda." Mr.

49 Wright suggested "Public Comment Regarding Land Use Matters." All agreed.

50 <u>Revisions to the General Plan</u>: Commissioner Roberts asked that they start with 51 Commissioner Lehnig's introduction changes. She clarified the population sources.

52 Discussion was had on how to address 200 East in the General Plan. PWD Nelson said he was 53 in a meeting with Logan City last Thursday and found out they have every intention of putting 200 54 East through. They discussed the significant impact 200 East will have on the Riverdale Area.

55 Councilmember Cooley suggested the general plan show 200 East as a regional corridor but note the

right-of- way is not preserved. More discussion was had. Commissioner Roberts proposed they hold off on making any changes to the transportation section while Commissioner Pitcher was absent

58 since he was the one over this section. Mr. Cooley agreed to wait for his input.

Commissioner Cooley reviewed the changes he made to the water section and received clarification from PWD Nelson on water figures. He addressed peak usage problems in July and August, in which the water pump cannot keep the reservoirs full, therefore he added, "The City should look at the pumping system to improve this capability to provide for future growth." He discussed the possibility of the city looking into an additional reservoir.

64 Commissioner Cooley pointed out that water usage is very difficult to project. He has run 65 some exercises by adding additional connections from a PUD which showed the city should have 66 enough water. He said he'd like to run another exercise, in the event that more property were 67 developed in the future.

Discussion was held on recommendations for water and sewer being under the sewer section.
Commissioner Cooley will make some revisions on how to divide them into the pertinent sections.

Discussion was held on the stormwater section. Commissioner Cooley will work with PWD^{*} Nelson on clarifications to the recommendations.

Discussion was held on utility easements. Councilmember Wright suggested calling some of the utility companies to see what they require for their easements. They referenced the city code. Commissioner Roberts suggested someone could review the code to make sure the city appropriately address utility easements.

Commissioner Roberts discussed the Affordable Housing section. He wasn't sure how to address the changes he sees need to be addressed. He said if he updates this section, it will trickle down and take some time. Councilmember Wright said it would be worth the time.

Commissioner Roberts informed that he will be gone during the next meeting. They decided to skip the next meeting and hold the next one on August 24.
